

Land Owned or Managed by The Council

- a) "The Poor Piece" - area of grazing land between 470m 'trig. Point' at Cop Round, to North of Bradwell Moor, extending to North East - let on Agricultural Tenancy.
- b) Registered Village Green - Goosehill Green.
- c) Registered Common Land - grassed area to Northern side of Market Square.
- d) Registered War Memorial (cross), Memorial Garden and Plinths of Rolls of Honour - Market Square triangular central area.
- e) Area of adopted land between Three Roofs Cafe and the Leet - small grassed verge, mid area subject to easement of right of access to residences and stone-delineated rectangular area immediately adjacent to Cafe, currently used with permission upon annual payment to Council for the placement of tables and chairs for customers' use.
- f) Burial Ground - Hollowford Lane.
- g) The strip of land at the end of the Burial Ground, separated with a gate and fence, is currently used by a private individual village resident (Mr N. Rowlands) with permission upon annual payment to Council for storage and occasional business-related use. This is not maintained by the Council at present.
- h) The Council is Custodian Trustee of the Castleton playing Fields Charity (Reg. No. 520429).
