Who to Contact

In the event of a flood, flood management authorities are often dealing with a large number of calls and it can be difficult to get through to the right authority or department to deal with your issue. Below is a list of appropriate contacts for Derbyshire.

The Environment Agency should be contacted where flooding has occurred from:

- A main river
- A reservoir

Contact your water company regarding flooding from:

- Public foul and surface water sewers
- A water main

- Surface water
- Ordinary watercourses (smaller watercourses, ditches and streams etc.)
- Groundwater

- Roadside drains (gullies) & standing water on the highway
