Terms and Conditions

- The raffle is authorised by Small Societies Lotteries Licence number HPKSL0229 issued by High Peak Borough Council.
- The raffle will be drawn in public on 27th November at 4 pm in the school playground .
- Tickets cost 50p (fifty pence) each.
- The prizes will be awarded in the order the tickets are drawn
- Tickets can only be sold to persons over the age of 16 years.
- The lottery is open to all over 16.
Participation in this lottery can only be made by purchase of a ticket.
- The organisers & beneficiaries accept no responsibility for tickets which are lost, damaged, or illegible or from which the prize-winner cannot be identified, or for any technical failure or event which may cause the competition to be disrupted or corrupted.
- Winning numbers will be announced after the draw, and displayed on the school notice board and outside the Village Hall on the village website www.castletonvillage.co.uk.
- Prizes are: 1st **£50**, 2nd **Christmas hamper** , many other smaller prizes
- Ticket purchasers must keep their ticket as proof of purchase and surrender it to claim the prize.
- Prizes may be collected on the day of the raffle , by contacting draw team and supplying a winning ticket and identification, if required. Prize money will be paid in cash on the day or by cheque by post if the winner is not present on the day.
- Where valid contact information is available, holders of winning tickets will be contacted by the organisers to arrange payment. Every effort will be made by the organisers to contact the winners. In the event the organisers are unable to contact a prize-winner after fourteen days of the raffle draw the prize will be forfeited and declared in the charities accounts as a donation to the charities funds.
- All winners are required to provide proof of age when requested.
- In the event of an error, howsoever caused, whether a printing error or otherwise and whether obvious or otherwise, which affects the competition in any way, the organisers reserve the right to administer the lottery as though the error had not occurred. Where the organiser deems it appropriate and/or feasible the organiser will notify entrants of the error on the village web site www.castletonvillage.co.uk.
